

## Standing Order - Deposit Account Facilities

Collectors can automatically receive Norfolk Island Philatelic material by establishing a Standing Order.

Standing Orders operate on a deposit account system and items are forwarded as long as the client's account is in credit.

A minimum deposit of \$20 (Australian) is suggested to be maintained to ensure continuity of service.

All stamps are sold at their face value. Payment can be made by Money Order, Postal Order, Bank Draft or Bank Notes, Bankcard (Australian), Mastercard or Visa. Payment should accompany orders.

All drafts or cheques in currency other than Australian currency should include an additional \$2.50 (Australian) to cover the fee charged by banks for conversion.

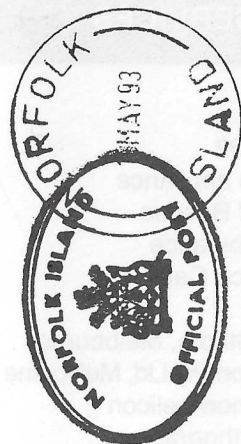
Clients are advised of their credit balance with each despatch. At times, however, due to early processing of orders this advice might not include the latest remittance received.

20 cents will be charged for servicing each order. All orders are despatched postage free and those exceeding \$20 are despatched by registered mail. Orders of lesser values are despatched by registered mail at the client's request and expense. The registered post charge (international service) is \$10 per article plus postage, and security post charge (Australian service) is \$7.50 per article plus postage.

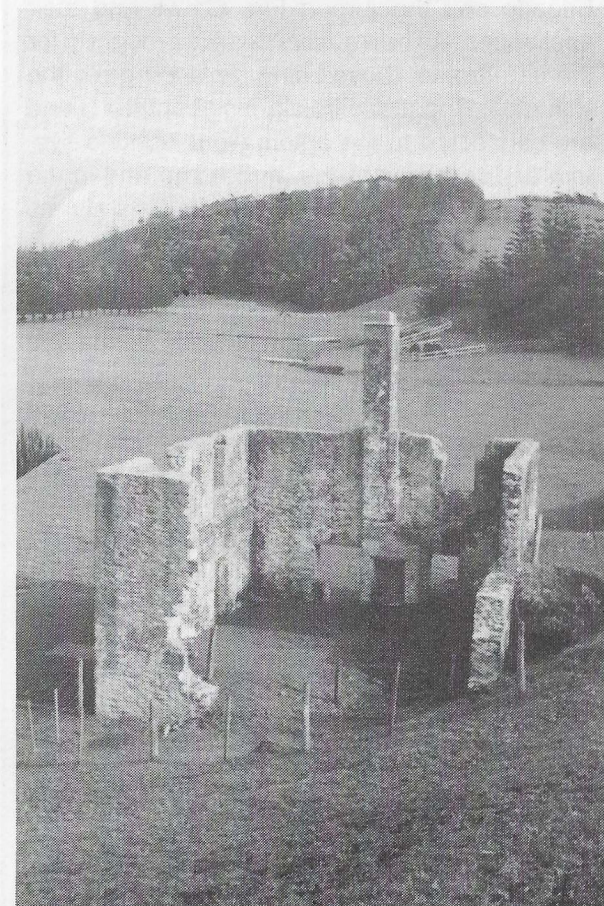

## Dear Customer

Emergencies occur on Norfolk Island as they do everywhere else, and coping with them falls to the lot of a mixture of professionals and enthusiasts: Police, firemen, medics and abseilers.

The Norfolk Island Police Force is staffed by three officers of the Australian Federal Police, supplemented by local special constables. Their vehicle is shown in the \$1.20 stamp.

The fire service is made up of the Volunteer Brigade and the Airport Fire Crews and their appliances. As new appliances are brought in for the aerodrome, those being replaced go to the Volunteer Brigade. Fire alarms about the island are connected to the automatic telephone system and to sirens at the aerodrome and in the central shopping area at Burnt Pine. Real alarms average about two a month.

Norfolk Island has one ambulance, shown on the 75¢ stamp. Based at the hospital it is staffed by members of St John Ambulance Brigade and is available 24 hours a day.

A cliff rescue and recovery service is provided by the Norfolk Island Volunteer Rescue Squad Inc., a volunteer service formed in 1985. They have facilities and trained staff for field command post, cliff rescue, vehicle extrication, communications, ground search, lighting, first aid, patient removal from ships, vertical shaft rescue and patient transportation. The squad is seen at work on the 70¢ stamp.

These expert services help to make Norfolk Island a reassuringly safe place to enjoy visiting.
