Dear Collector,

The Pacific Sun made her maiden visit to Norfolk Island on March 26, marking the return of P&O Cruises to the Island 78 years after the visit of the RMS Strathaird.

The weather certainly turned on the charm and the ship anchored off Cascade Bay and 1900 passengers came ashore via tender to explore the island and its many attractions.

Market stalls were set up in town and the cafés were humming with activity throughout the whole day and into the early evening.

The arrival of so many people in one day gave the Island a festive feel and this carried on until the last tender returned to the ship and the Pacific Sun sailed on to its next destination.

The island is now getting ready for the Country Music Festival. This event always takes place in the latter part of May and there will be many artists visiting the island for this week from both Australia and New Zealand. Country Music has quite a following on Norfolk Island and a number of tour groups travel to the island especially for the Country Music Week.

The Norfolk Island Rescue Squad recently purchased a specially designed rescue truck from Narrandera Volunteer Rescue Service in NSW.

The vehicle arrived on our last cargo ship and was transported ashore in the usual manner, by strapping together 2 lighters, and towed ashore by the Government Launch. This mode of transporting vehicles from ship to shore is quite a unique but effective method. Norfolk Island has very skilled lighterage workers.

On ABC's Pacific Beat radio program a couple of weeks back a discussion was taking place regarding an adventure about to be undertaken by Mr Don McIntyre, an Australian adventurer. Mr McIntyre was about to embark on a sea voyage to re-enact the voyage of Captain William Bligh. History has recorded that Bligh was set adrift in an open boat and covered a voyage distance of 3,700 miles, from Tahiti to Timor.

By the time this bulletin is distributed Mr McIntyre will already be at sea in a replica of Bligh's 25-foot long boat 221 years after the original mutiny voyage.

This expedition is being undertaken to raise funds for the Sheffield Institute for Motor Neurone Disease.. A worthy cause and we wish them a safe journey.

NEW STAMP ISSUES



They came aboard the Morayshire

This issue depicts men and women who travelled to Norfolk Island from Pitcairn Island aboard the Morayshire.

The island of Pitcairn became a British colony in 1838, however, by the mid 1850s the Pitcairn community was outgrowing the island and they appealed to Queen Victoria to help them. Queen Victoria offered them Norfolk Island and on 3 May 1856 the entire community of 193 Pitcairn Islanders set sail for Norfolk Island on board the Morayshire. The voyage was a difficult one and they arrived at Norfolk Island 5 weeks later, on 8 June 1856.

During the voyage a baby was born bringing the passenger numbers to 194 on arrival at Norfolk Island.

Many aspects of their new home astonished the Pitcairn Islanders. There were massive stone buildings, cattle, horses and gardens of flowers and exotic fruits and vegetables, the like of which they had never seen before. There were even lavatories and their purpose had to be explained. It is written that the mopokes or "Ghost Birds" terrified the newcomers.

The Pitcairn people adapted to their new home. Bishop Selwyn, who had designated Norfolk 'the Ocean Hell' when he visited it in convict



days, now wrote: 'I doubt not that eventually the presence of the Pitcairn people will render it what nature intended it to be - an earthly paradise' ...and so it remains today.

After 18 months on Norfolk Island 17 people returned to Pitcairn and 5 years later another 27 returned.

Every year on 8 June a re-enactment of this landing is celebrated and known as Bounty or Anniversary Day.

The gutter strip in this issue shows the names of every passenger aboard the Morayshire on this historical voyage.

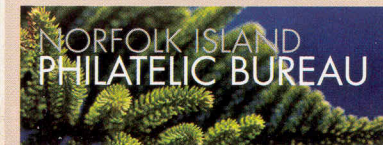
