Quota Club International Inc. began on 6th February, 1919 in Buffalo New York. It was the first international club for women and it was an organisation of service and friendship, which embraced members regardless of geographic location.

15th August, 2014 is the 35th Anniversary of the N.I. Quota Club.

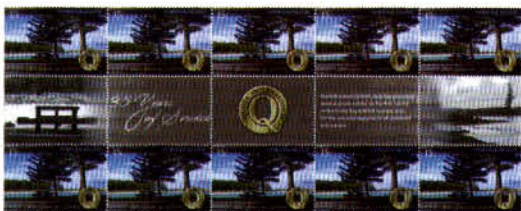
\$0.15c - Features a BBQ tables over looking Emily Bay. Quota has been providing this type of BBQ table at the Lone Pine area.

\$0.70c - Features the Telescope that Quota has installed at the Queen Elizabeth Lookout. Monies raised from the use of this Telescope are donated to the Service Fund.

\$3.20 - Features the Memorial Seat that Quota provided, being used by a young family relaxing and looking out to sea.

Government House is the image on the First Day Cover. 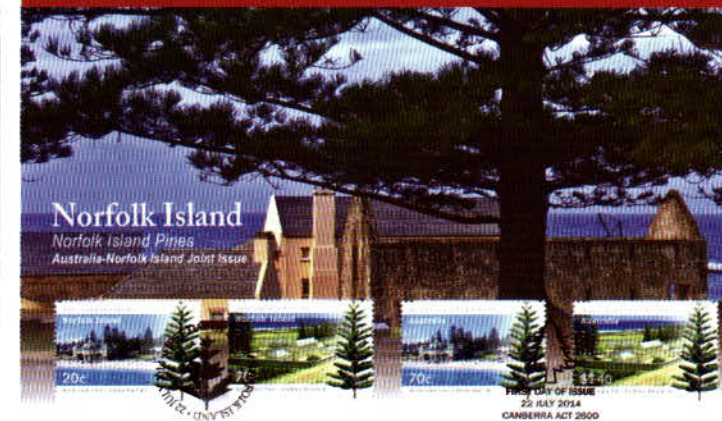

100th Anniversary

On July 1st, 2013 Norfolk Island became the 2nd External Territory of the Commonwealth of Australia. N.I. Philatelic Bureau and Australia Post have release 2 stamps each to mark the 100th Anniversary of this event.

The Norfolk Island Pine *Araucaria heterophylla* features this stamp issue, as it grows well in both Norfolk Island and Australia.

.20c - Norfolk Island stamp features Cottesloe Beach of Western Australia.

.70c - Norfolk Island stamp features the Old Military Barracks at Kingston, which is where Legislative Assembly meetings are held.

The First Day Cover - image has been taken from the verandah of what is now known as the "The Lions Club"

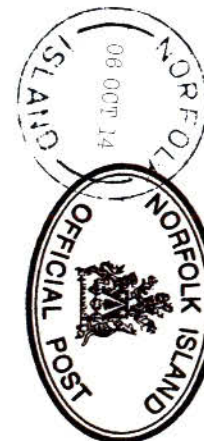
