Welcome, to Bulletin 2 for 2015 featuring the Local Post Booklet and Christmas in July issues, but first some exciting news about Tracey Yager, who was the artist for some of Norfolk's previous stamp designs, "Calm Waters", "Werken Dar Shep", Sesqui-Centenary Part 2 & the Lighter Boat Aerogramme being 4 of them.

The Australian Wooden Boat Festival was held in Hobart, Tasmania in February of this year, it was attended by thousands of people. One of the key marketing tools for attracting this crowd was a beautiful advertising poster designed and sketched by Tracey. Having been impressed by the 2011 Australian Wooden Boat Festival, Tracey entered the advertising poster competition for the 2015 festival, and to her credit, she was the winner.

With her poster attracting wooden boat enthusiasts from across Australia and New Zealand, Tracey decided to create a collection of paintings of wooden boats to exhibit at the festival. The collection was so impressive that Tracey was invited to become a member of the Maritime Artists' Association of Australia.

Tracey's Wooden Boats collection depicts a range of crafts at work and at rest, from tiny row boats to yachts. There are also a couple of paintings that feature waterside environments that wooden boats frequent. All are lyrical water colours that capture light, reflections and the elegant shapes of wooden craft.

If you should ever come to Norfolk Island, I highly recommend that you visit the Gallery Guava and Cyclorama which was painted by Tracey Yager, Sue Draper and Glenn Douran, all who have designed stamps for the N.I. Philatelic Bureau. Collectors may remember the 2006 Sesqui-Centenary part 1 stamp issue which was comprised of images from the Cyclorama.

The "2015 Christmas in July" festival begins on Norfolk Island on 13th of July. The week will commence on the Monday night with a tribute performance to the Legends of Rock, Elvis Presley, Johnny O'Keefe and Buddy Holly. Australia's Dean Vegas as Elvis, Dennis Hopkins as Johnny O'Keefe and Kris Knight as Buddy Holly. On the following nights, the audience will be entertained by New Zealand singers Suzanne Prentice, John Rowles, along with Australian singer, Normie Rowe. There are 5 stamps in this set, and the First Day Cover has been printed with a Christmas theme.



### 0.25c JOHN ROWLES

John is one of New Zealand's most iconic male artists and he has an extensive musical background. John's first song "All Shook Up" in a talent quest at the age of 10 where won first prize. Hitting his stride in the 1970's and 1980's, John has been performed in places such as Sydney and Melbourne of Australia, New Zealand, Italy, Germany, Britain, Spain, USA, Rio de Janeiro. In 1969 John was invited to represent New Zealand for the Rio de Janeiro song festival. John wrote the song "Cheryl Moana Marie" named after one of his younger sisters for this festival. Forty-two countries were represented at the festival and John's song was voted in at number 5. Cheryl Moana Marie reached number one in the New Zealand charts, and it was very popular on Norfolk Island as well. In 1974 John received the Benny award from the Variety Artists Club of New Zealand Inc the highest honour available to a New Zealand Variety entertainer. John will be singing on Thursday 16th July.



### 0.35c SUZANNE PRENTICE

Suzanne's first performed at the 1970 Invercargill A & P Summer show talent quest. She was just 12 years old when she won this talent quest. Suzanne's awards include Top Female vocalist, Australasian Best Female Vocalist, Gold reel award for excellence in recording (USA). Suzanne's albums have reached platinum, double platinum and gold status. Suzanne has also written two bestselling books. Suzanne's career has spanned 40 years and has performed with artists such as Dolly Parton. Suzanne has also received an O.B.E. for her services to music. Suzanne will be singing on Tuesday 14th July.

### 0.45c NORMIE ROWE

Aussie icon and 1960's superstar Normie Rowe with hits "It Ain't Necessarily So", "Shakin' all Over", "Que Sera Sera", will be entertaining this week. Normie became the first Melbourne recording artist to achieve an Australian Number 1. In 1965 Normie joined The Easy Beats, Bobby & Laurie and NPD limited on "The Big Four" national tour that played to huge crowds around the country. Normie then served in Vietnam and on his return started in The Don Lane Show, The Mike Walsh Show as well as roles in TV's Son's and Daughters and critical acclaim and outstanding performance in Les Miserables in 1987. Normie will be singing on Wednesday July 15th.



### 1.40c GLENN A. BAKER

Australian journalist and broadcaster is well known in Australia for his vast knowledge of Rock music, he has written books and magazine articles on rock music and travel, interviewed celebrities, managed bands and promoted tours of international stars. Glenn has won the inaugural Australian Travel Writer of the year award in 1995 from the Australian Society of Travel Writers, and won the award again in 2000. Glenn will be 2015 "Christmas in July" Master of Ceremonies.



### 1.95c COLLEEN MCCULLOUGH

Dr Colleen McCullough lived on Norfolk Island for 36 years. Prior to her world wide success as an author, Colleen was a neuro-scientist working at the Sydney's Royal North Shore Hospital. Colleen has written over 25 books and they include histories, murder mysteries, love stories, intellectual novels, biographies, satires, essays, poems, song lyrics and operas. All of her books have been translated into thirty plus languages, sell in many thousands, some few in the millions, some are recommended reading in great universities. With titles such as "Tim" "The Thorn Birds" (both of which have been made into movies); 7 book series for the "Masters of the Rome", "Morgans Run", "The Ladies of Misalonghi", "Life without the Boring Bits", "Rodan Cutler VC", "The Bitter Sweet", Colleen's books grace book shelves all over the world. In 2006 Colleen was awarded the "the Order of Australia" for "Services to the Arts and the Community". At the 2014 Christmas in July 2014, guests were treated to a lunch with Colleen. Colleen was scheduled to be a part of this years Festival, when she sadly passed away in January of this year. Guests will be attending an Afternoon Tea at Colleen's house on Tuesday.
