

## Standing Order - Deposit Account Facilities

Collectors can automatically receive Norfolk Island Philatelic material by establishing a Standing Order.

Standing Orders operate on a deposit account system and items are forwarded as long as the client's account is in credit.

A minimum deposit of \$20 (Australian) is suggested to be maintained to ensure continuity of service.

All stamps are sold at their face value. Payment can be made by Money Order, Postal Order, Bank Draft or Bank Notes, Bankcard (Australian), Mastercard or Visa. Payment should accompany orders.

All drafts or cheques in currency other than Australian currency should include an additional \$2.50 (Australian) to cover the fee charged by banks for conversion.

Clients are advised of their credit balance with each despatch. At times, however, due to early processing of orders this advice might not include the latest remittance received.

20 cents will be charged for servicing each order. All orders are despatched postage free and those exceeding \$20 are despatched by registered mail. Orders of lesser values are despatched by registered mail at the client's request and expense. The registered post charge (international service) is \$10 per article plus postage, and security post charge (Australian service) is \$7.50 per article plus postage.

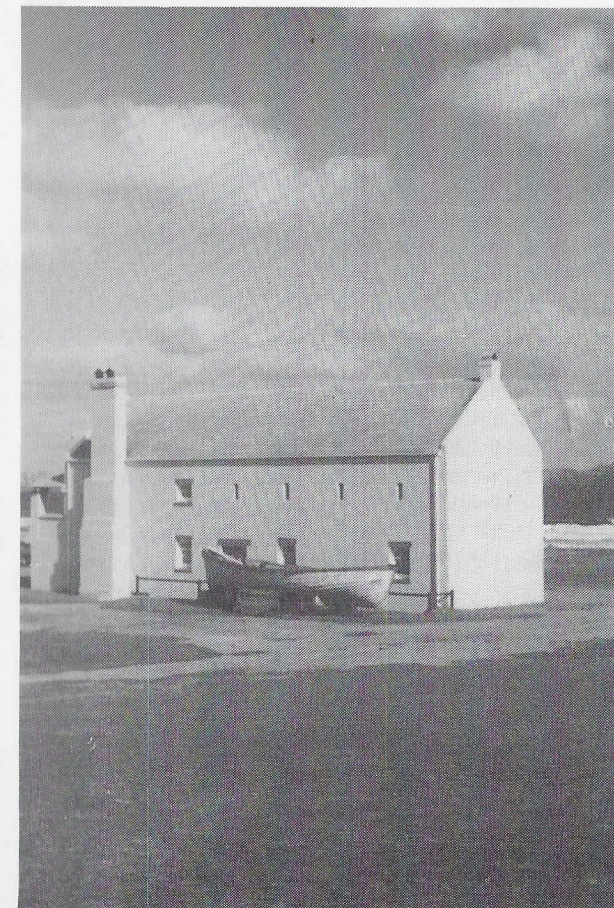

**BOOKLETS:** As stocks of booklet covers ran out, it was decided to fill existing orders but not to have further covers printed for the 45¢ & 70¢ Shipping stamps. The \$4.50 booklet was therefore discontinued at the close of September, and the \$7.00 booklet is close to being exhausted as this goes to press. The next booklet will appear with the issue of the setenant strip of five 45¢ stamps on 23 February 1993.

### SPECIAL POSTMARKERS:

**11 Nov 1992 - VISIT OF SURVIVING ANZAC VICTORIA CROSS WINNERS** - The local RSL Sub Branch is arranging a visit to Norfolk Island of the surviving Anzac VC winners for Remembrance Day 11 November 1992. To mark the occasion all mail posted in Norfolk Island on that day will be cancelled with a special postmarker, as shown.

**30 NOV - 6 DEC 1992: OCEANIA GAMES** - During the week that the Oceania Games are being held in Norfolk Island, mail posted in Norfolk Island and cancelled on those days will be cancelled with a special postmarker, as shown.

**RSL VC WINNERS VISIT COMMEMORATIVE COVER:** In the last bulletin, more information on this was promised. Firstly, the envelope is NOT a Postal Service item, but is being offered by the local Sub Branch of the RSL (Returned Servicemens League) to mark the occasion of the visit of the five surviving Anzac VC winners, and to help defray the costs of the visit. The envelope will be available from THE SECRETARY, NORFOLK ISLAND RSL SUB BRANCH, P.O. BOX 162, NORFOLK ISLAND 2899. I am told that a limited number of covers autographed by the VC winners will be available at \$10 each, and that unautographed covers will be available for \$3 each (see picture), after 11 November 1992. Our role is to tell about it.

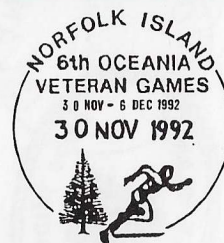

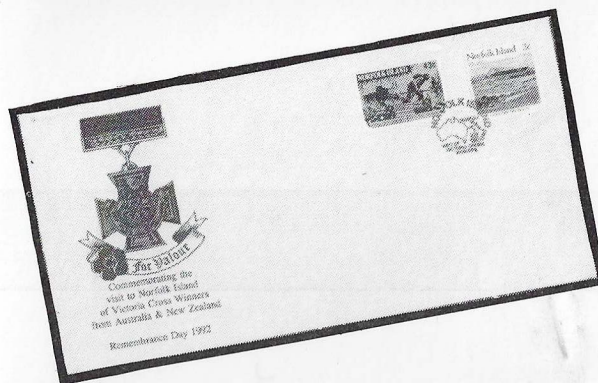
